If you suspect an infant, child or young adult of having a development delay or disability, your school can open a window of hope for a brighter future.

Services at no cost to the family are available to all eligible individuals from 3 through 21 years of age (starting at birth for auditory and/or visual impairments) regardless of the severity of their disability.

Special services are available to eligible infants, children and young adults identified with a disability who may be experiencing difficulties in one or more of the following areas:

- *Auditory Impairment *Autism *Deaf-Blindness *Emotional Disturbance
- *Intellectual Disability *Other Health Impairment
- *Orthopedic Impairment *Specific Learning Disability
- *Speech or Language Impairment *Traumatic Brain Injury
- *Visual Impairment
